Proverbs 22:1

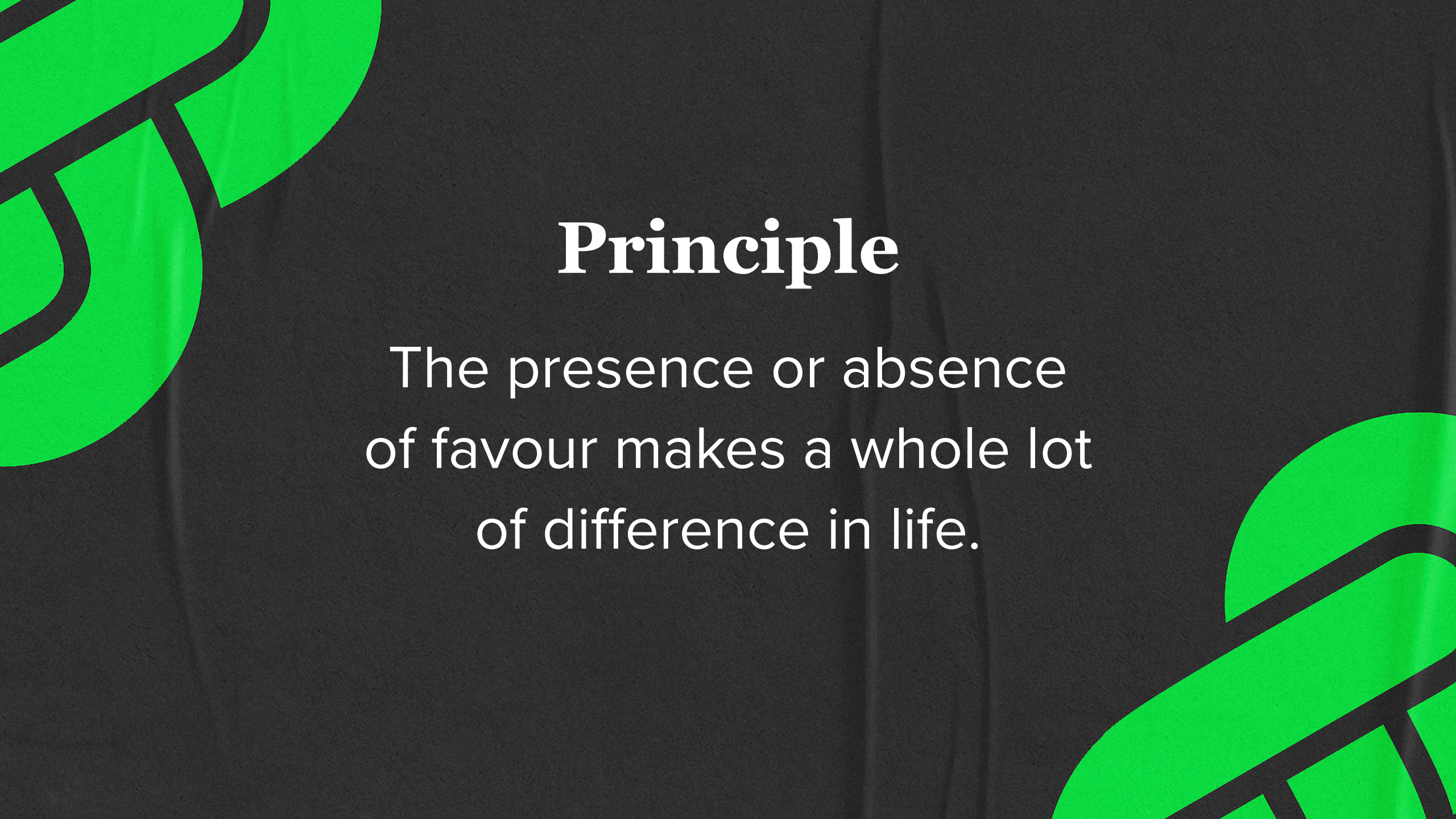
A good name is to be chosen

The **LORD** looked with favour on Abel and his offering, ⁵ but on Cain and his offering **he did not look with favour.**

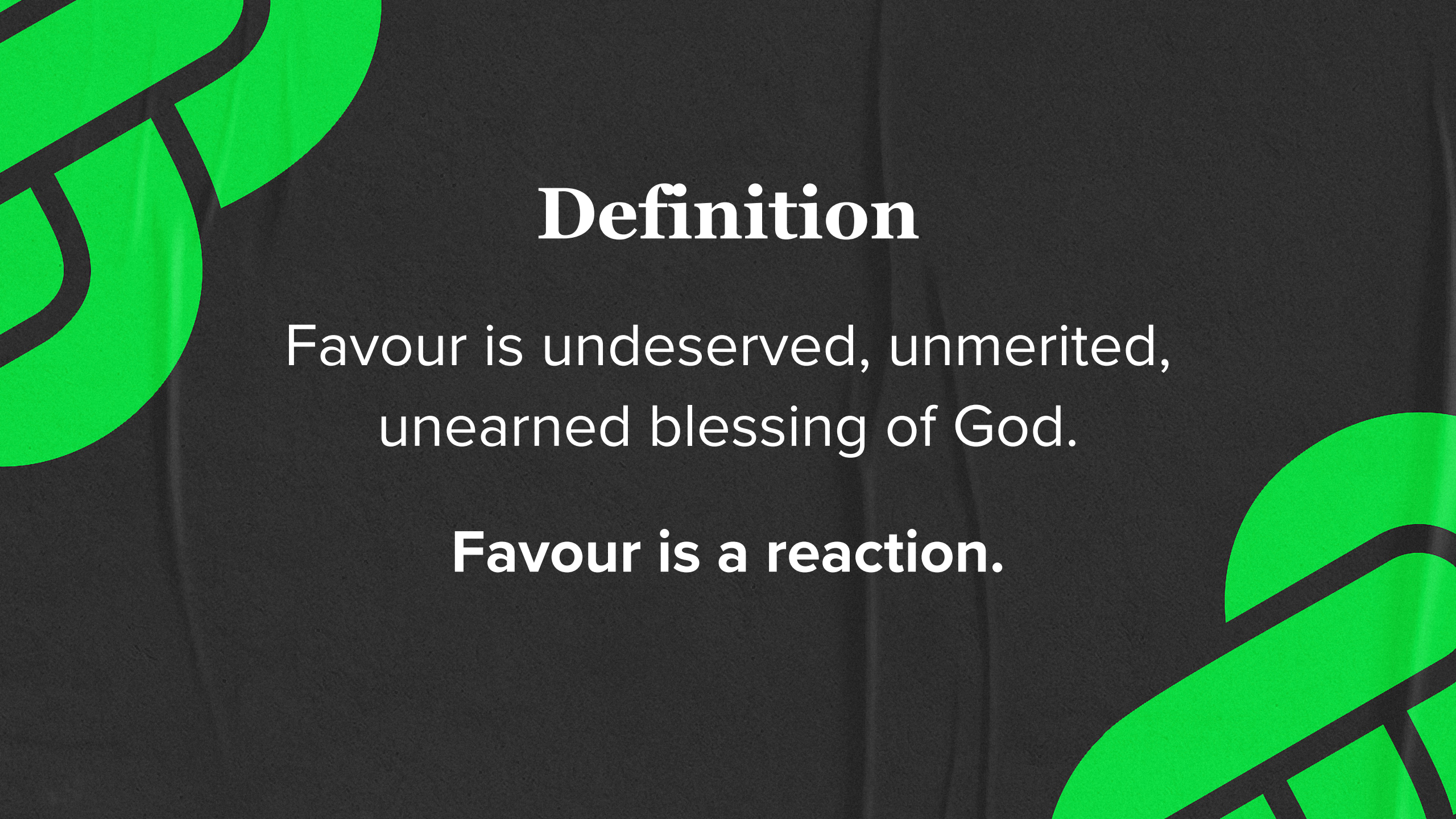


Principle

of difference in life.



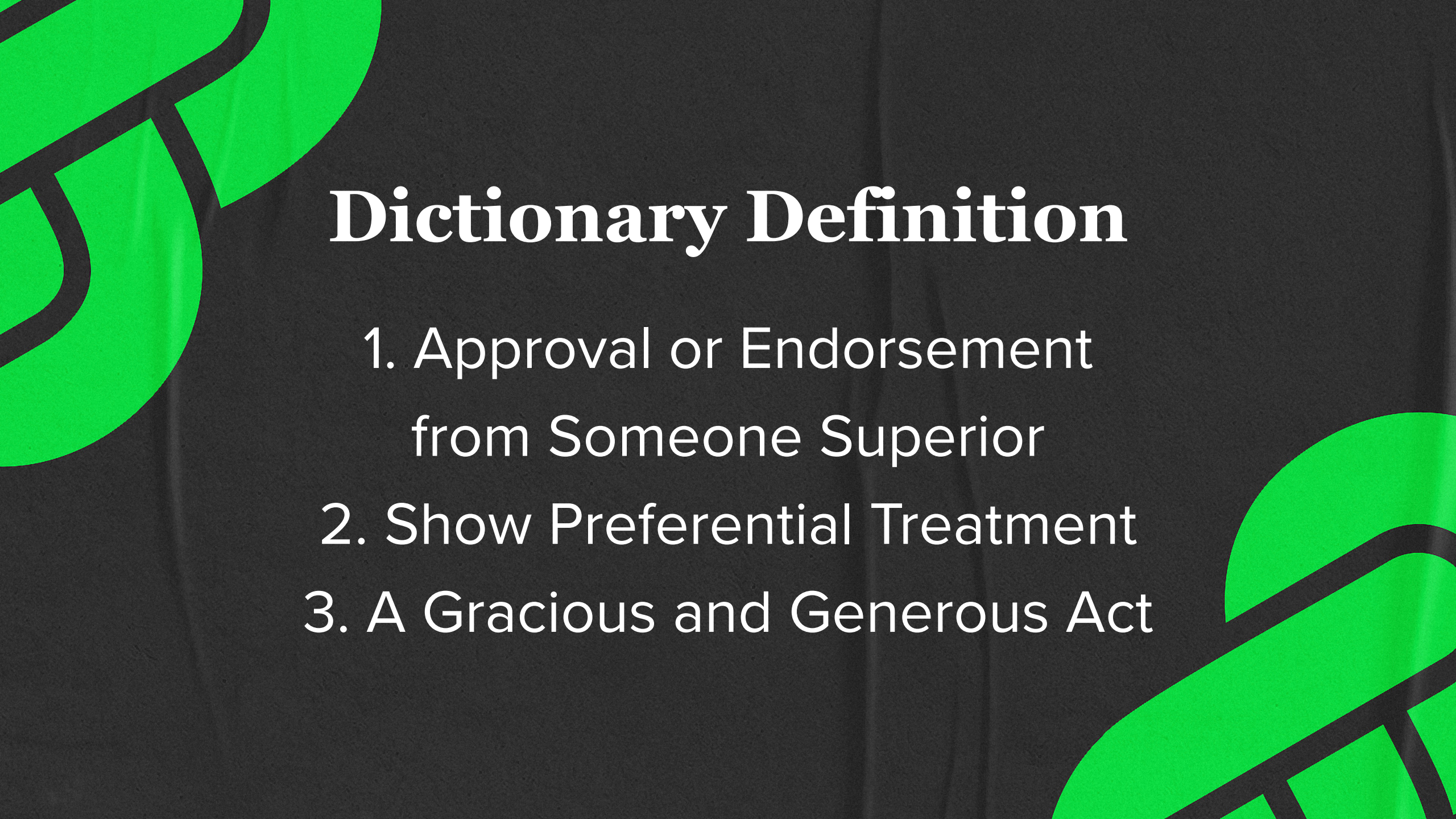

Definition

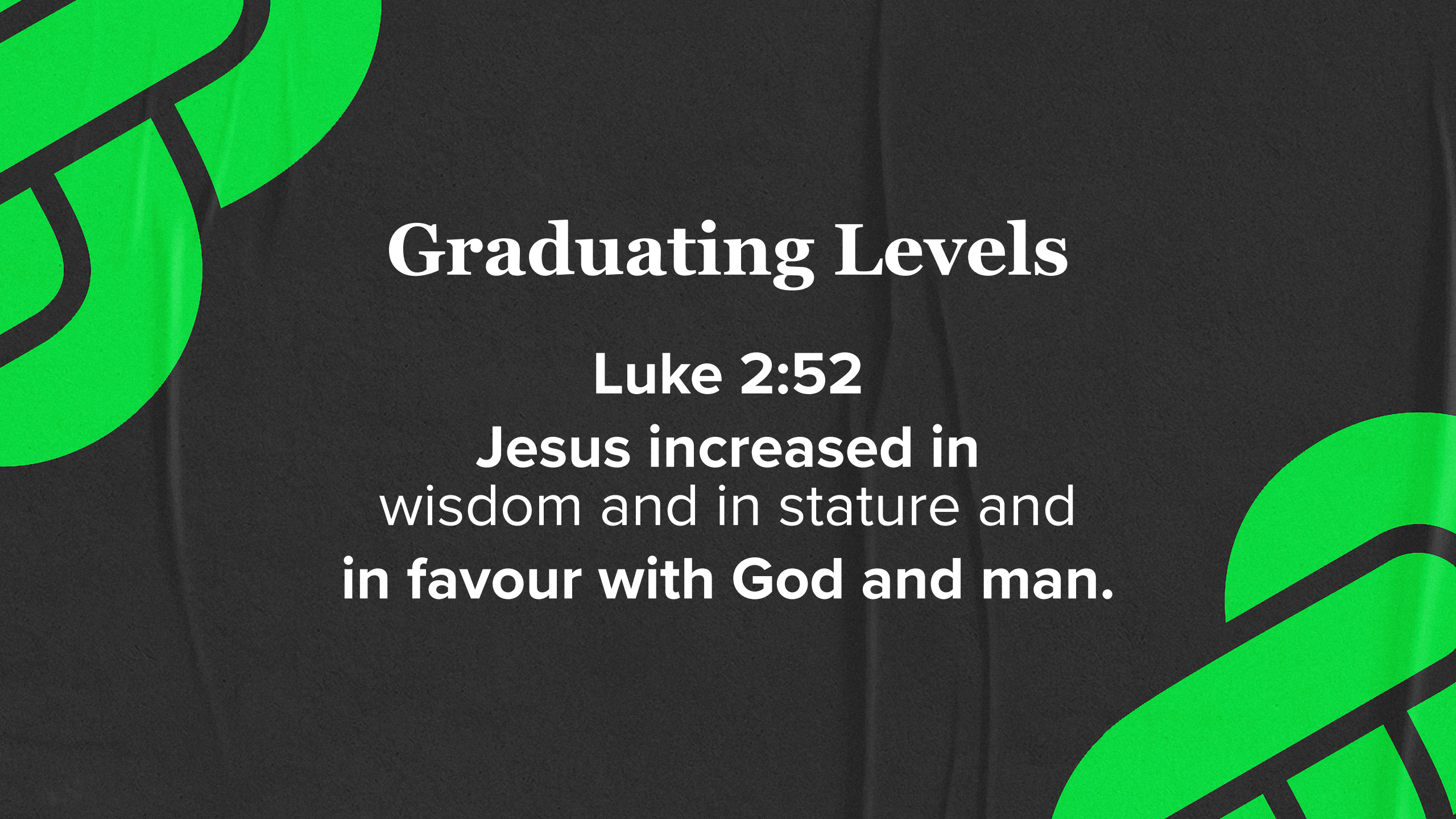
Favour is undeserved, unmerited,
unearned blessing of God.

What will cause a **RULER** to hand over his entire nation to a **SLAVE** to rule over a single conversation?

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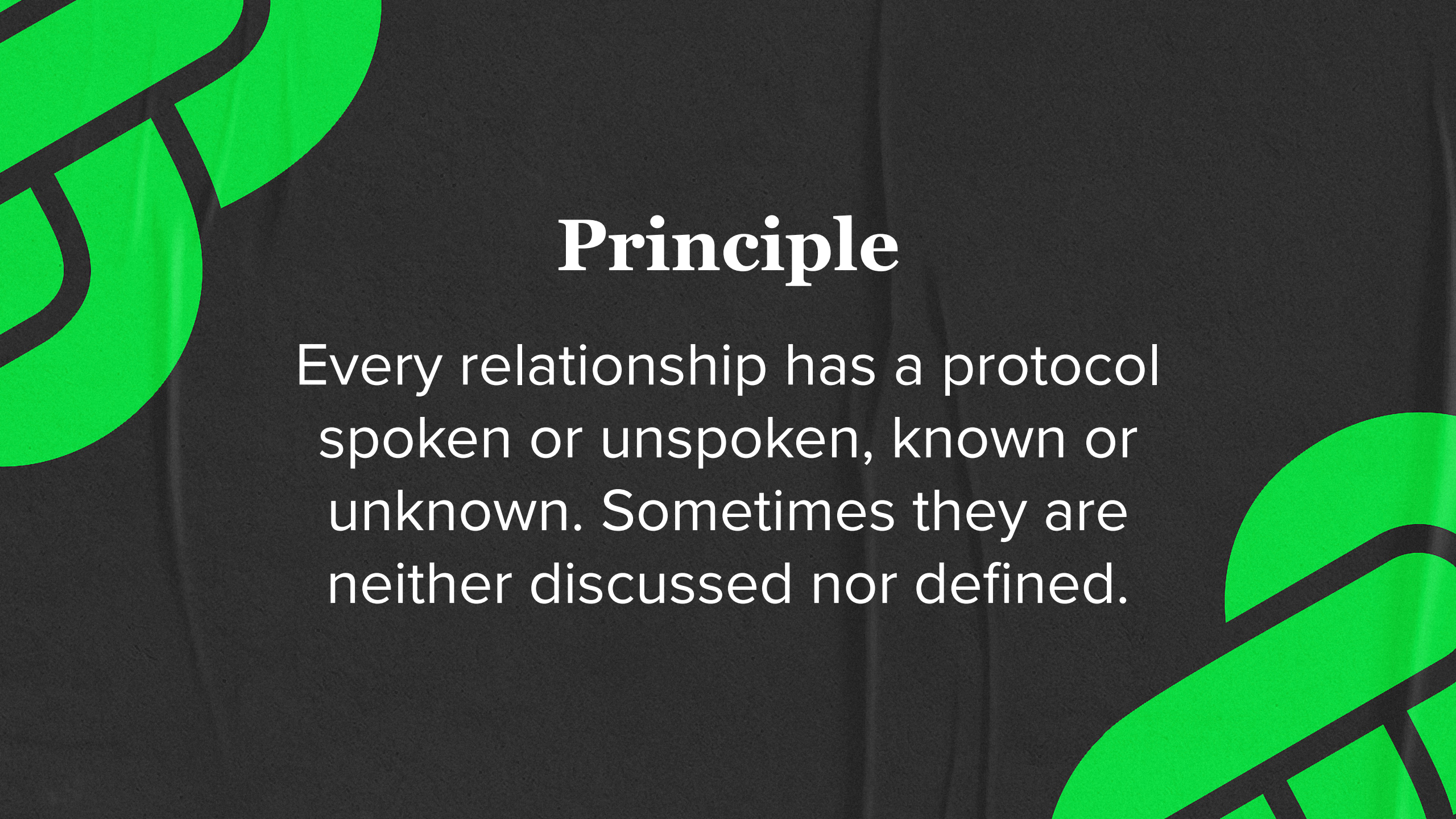
The Key of PROTOCOL

Ruth 2:8-9



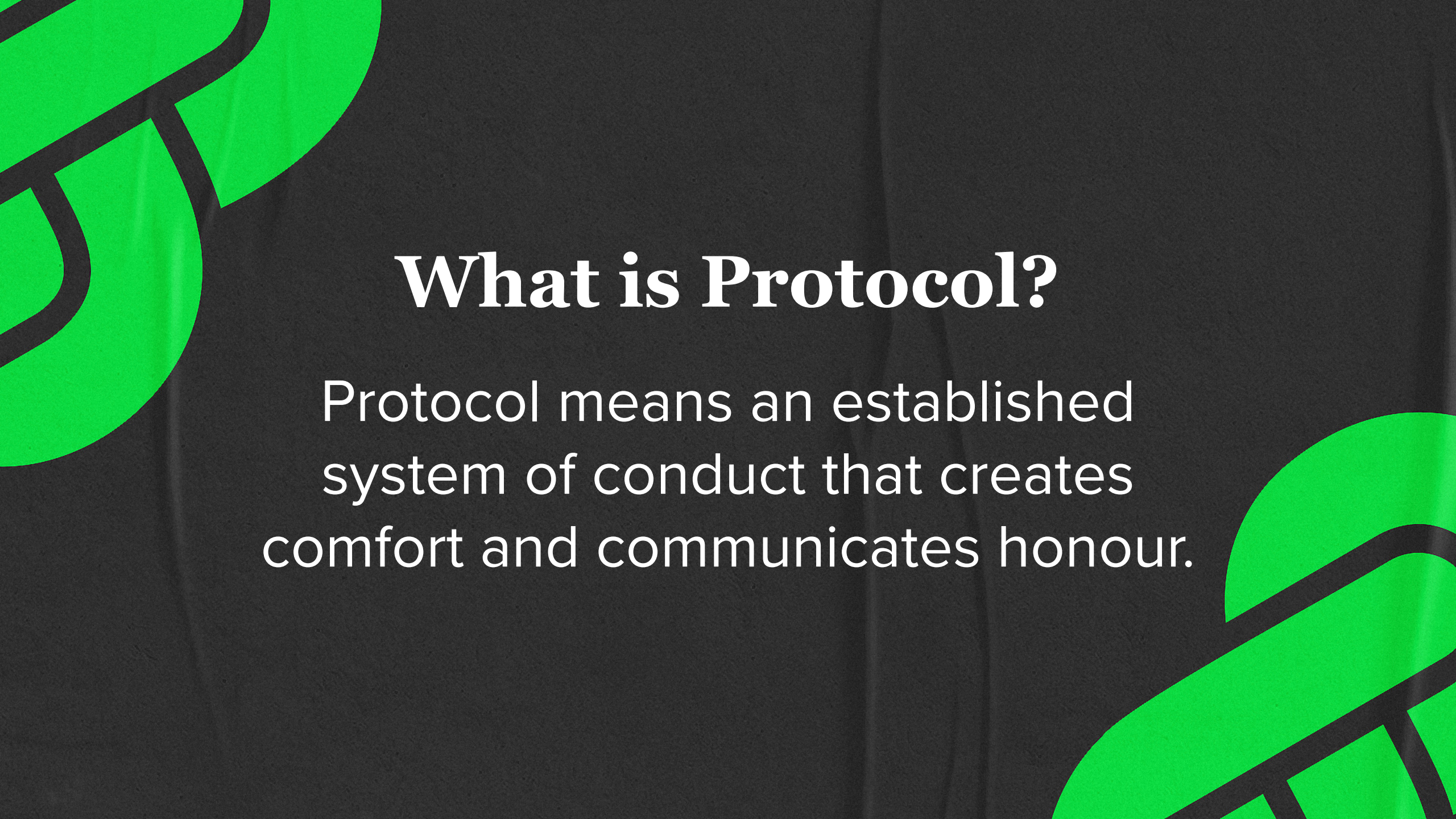
⁸ Then Boaz said to Ruth, “**Now, listen, my daughter, do not go to glean in another field** or leave this one, but **keep close to my young women**.”

⁹ Let your eyes be on the field that they are reaping, and go after them. **Have I not charged the young men not to touch you?** And when you are thirsty, go to the vessels and drink what the young men have drawn.”



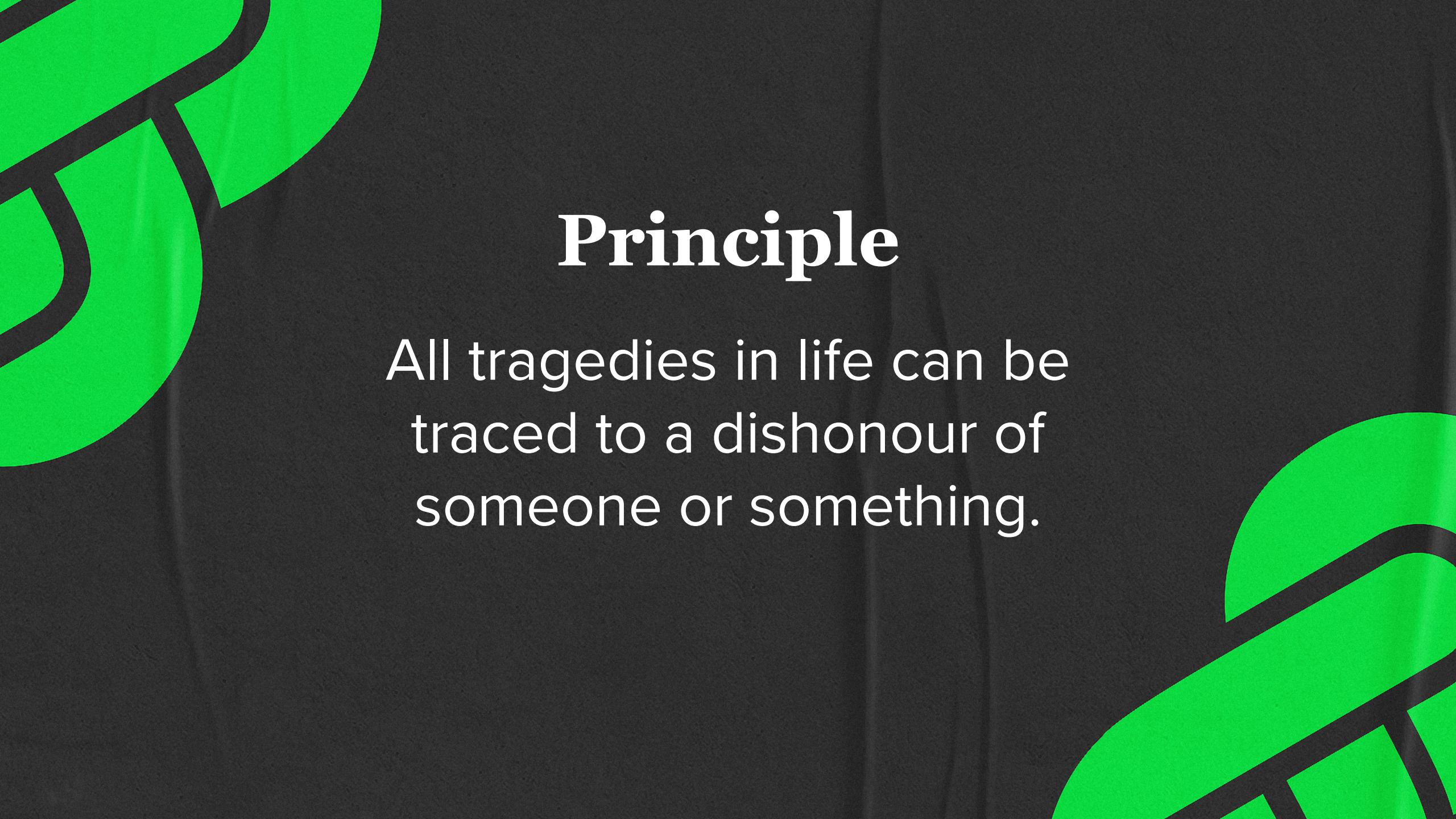
Principle

Every relationship has a protocol spoken or unspoken, known or unknown. Sometimes they are neither discussed nor defined.



What is Protocol?

Protocol means an established system of conduct that creates comfort and communicates honour.

The Key of **SERVANTHOOD**

Ruth 2:2

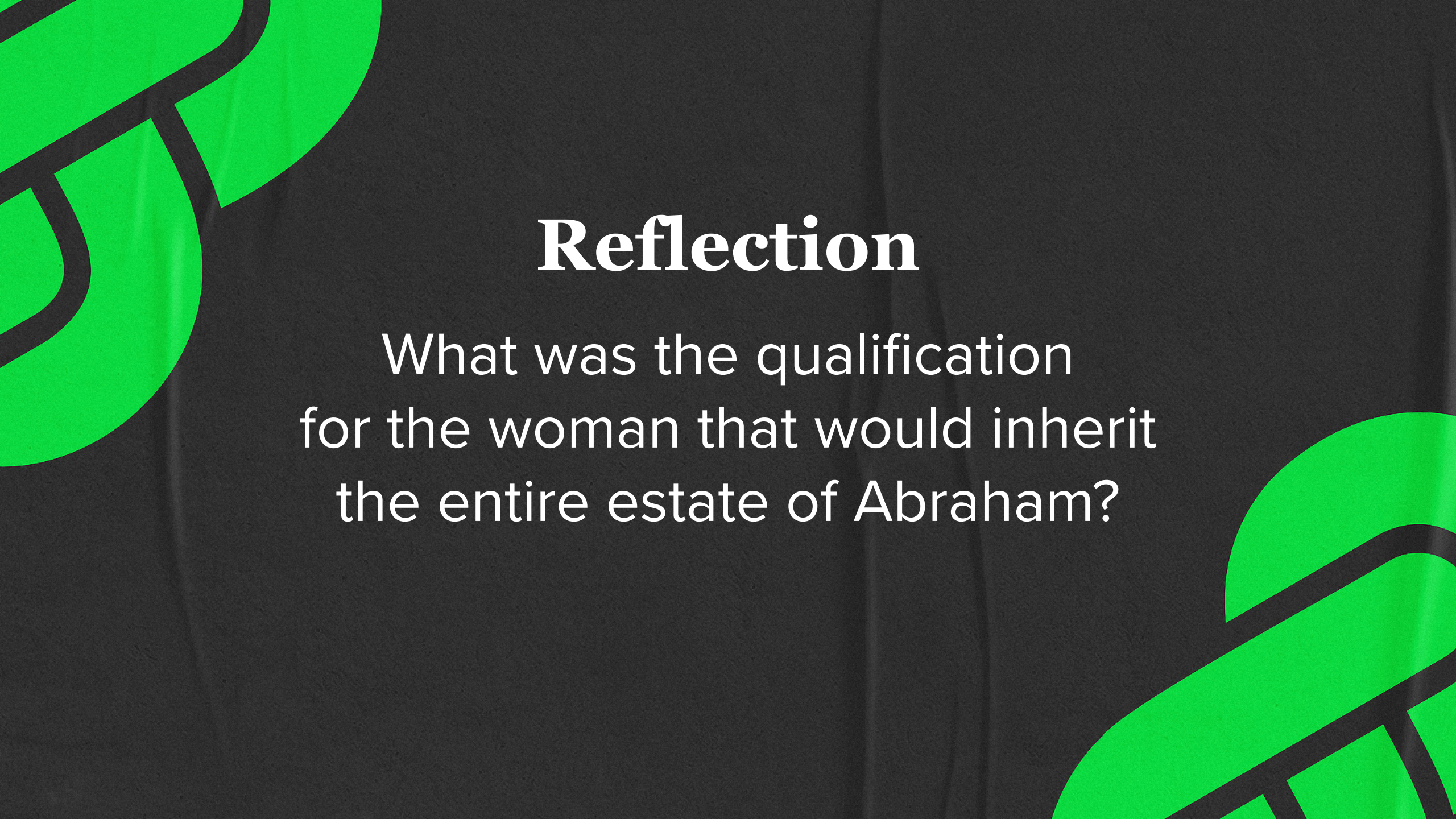


² And Ruth the Moabite said to Naomi, “**Let me go to the field and glean among the ears of grain after him in whose sight I shall find favour.**”

Three Workings of the Favour of God



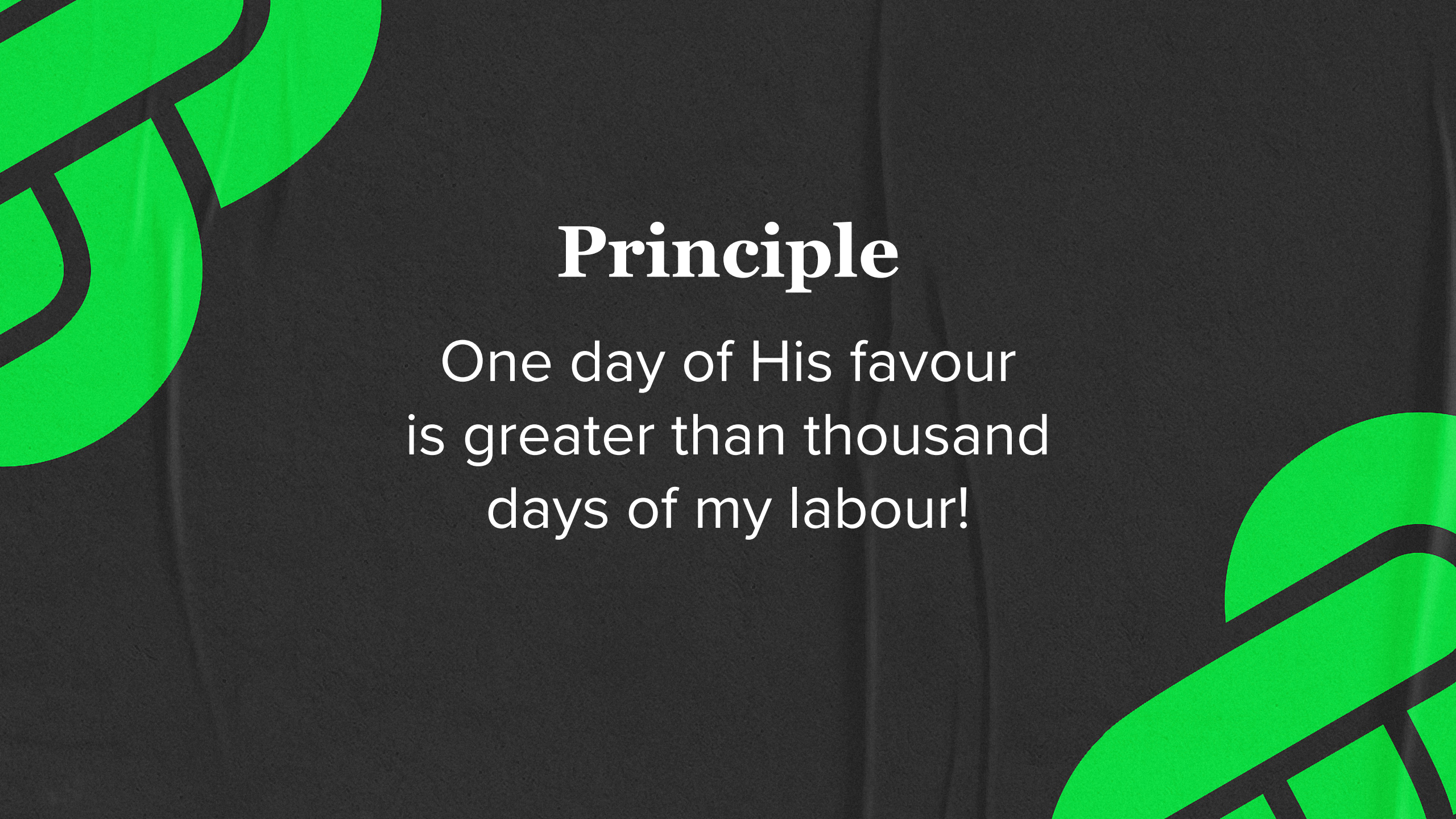
**1. God's favour

**2. God's favour
follows His Sovereign
plan and purpose.**



**3. God's favour
is freely given in
His appointed time.**
