
**Life thrives in

Thankful is an expression of a pleased and relieved emotion.


Grateful is an expression of showing an appreciation of kindness.

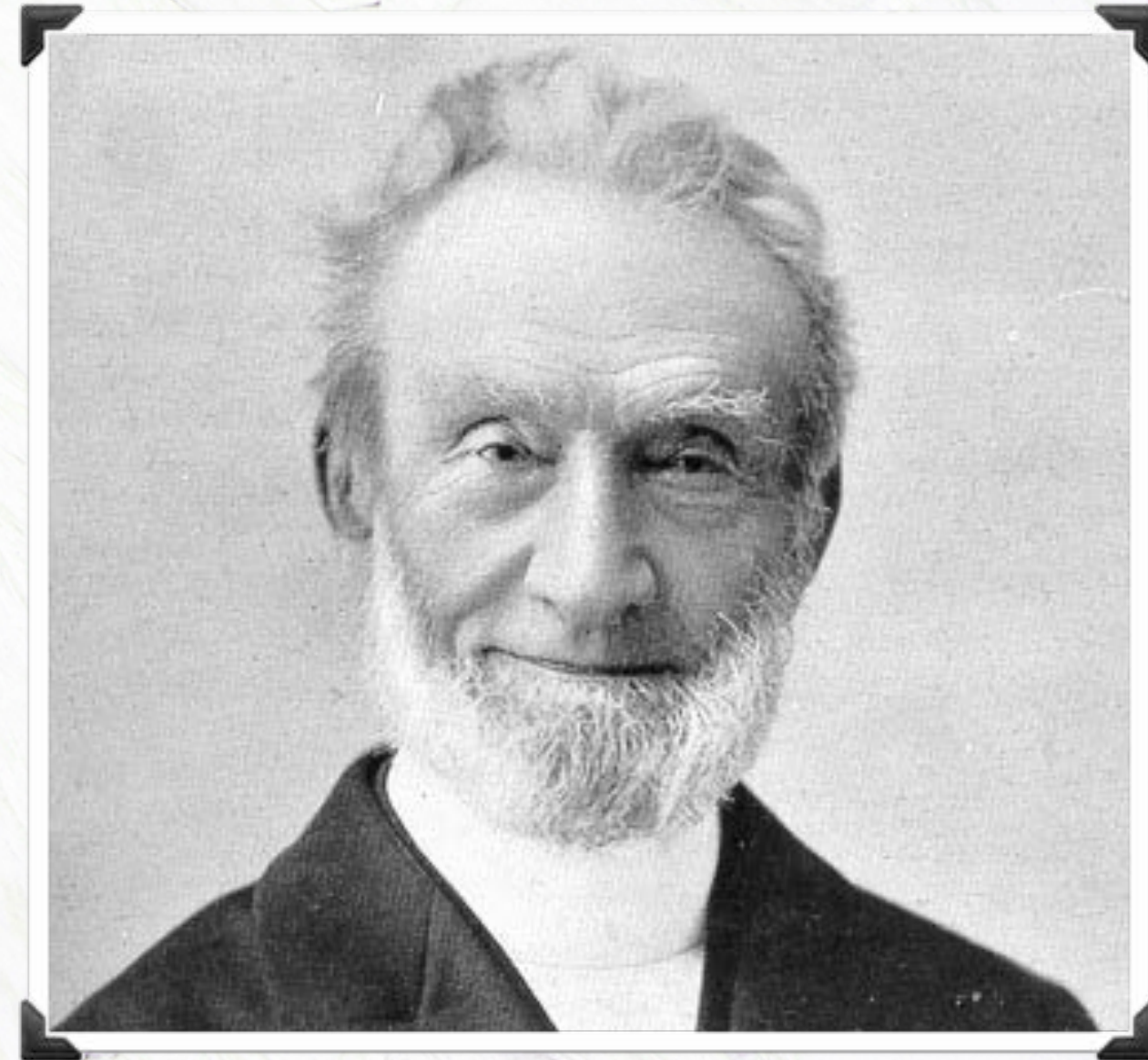
