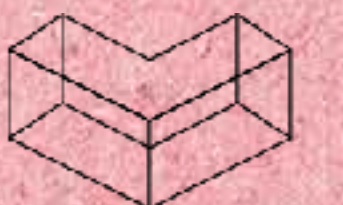

The main consideration for the location of any city or town in days of antiquity is its proximity to a water source, because without water, a city, town or a village couldn't survive.

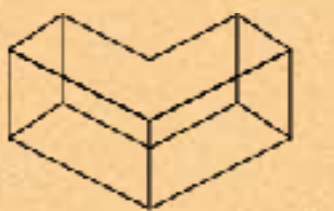

put a well in that person.

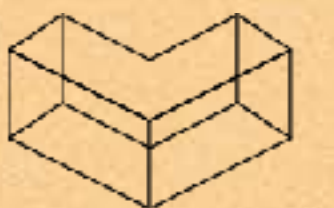

baptised in the Holy Spirit.

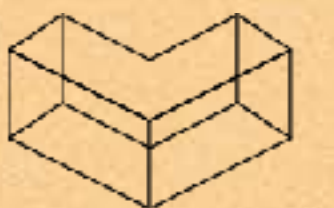

and become a mighty river.

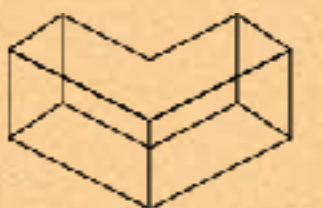


CORNERSTONE

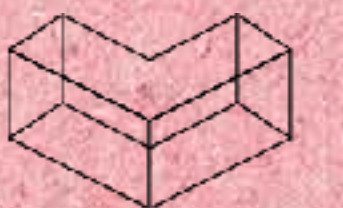

dig the well.



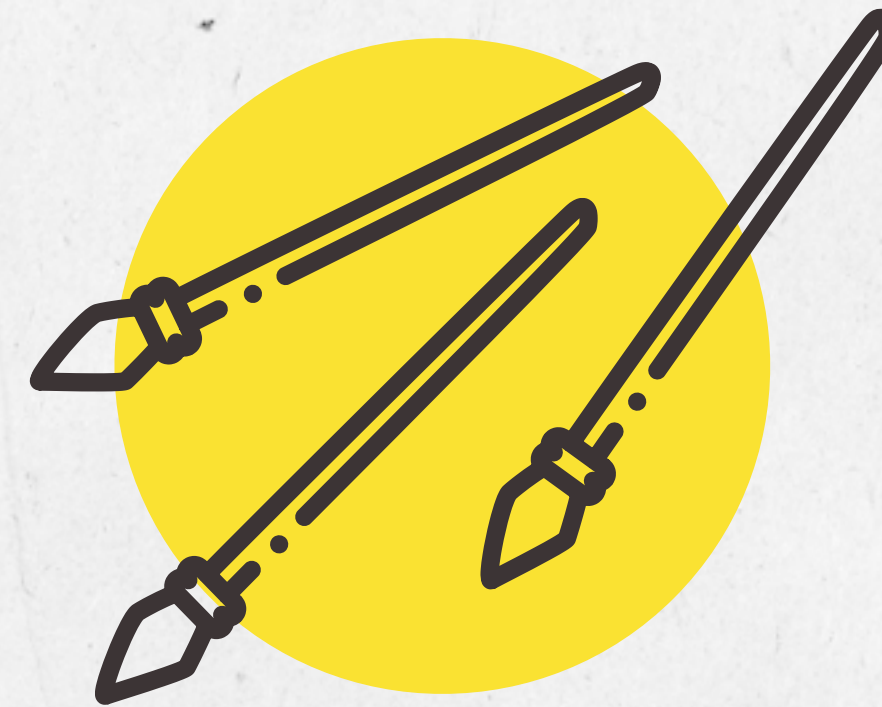
The congregation

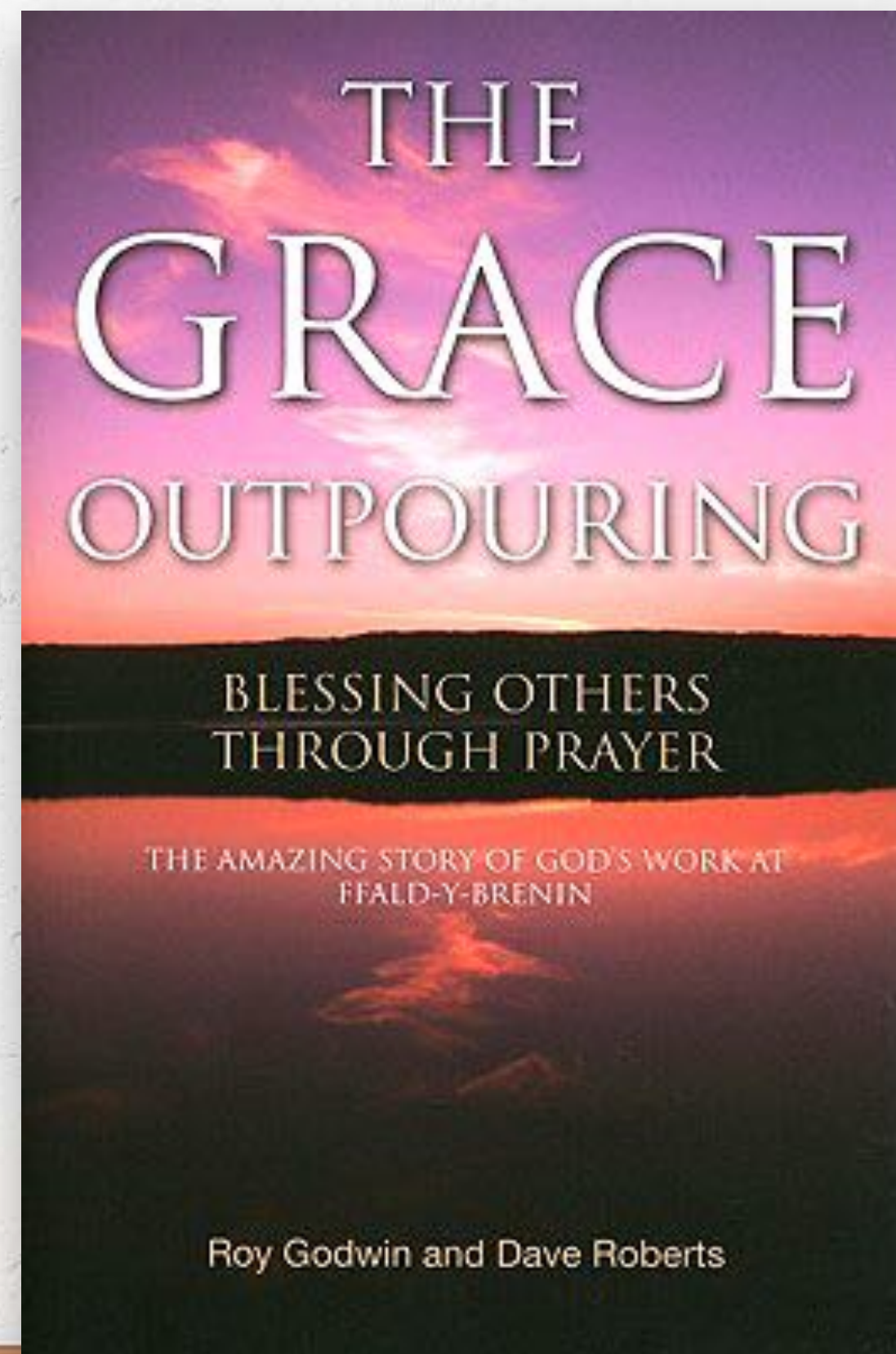

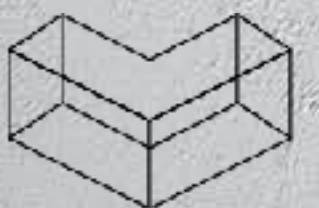
