through ~~FAITH~~.

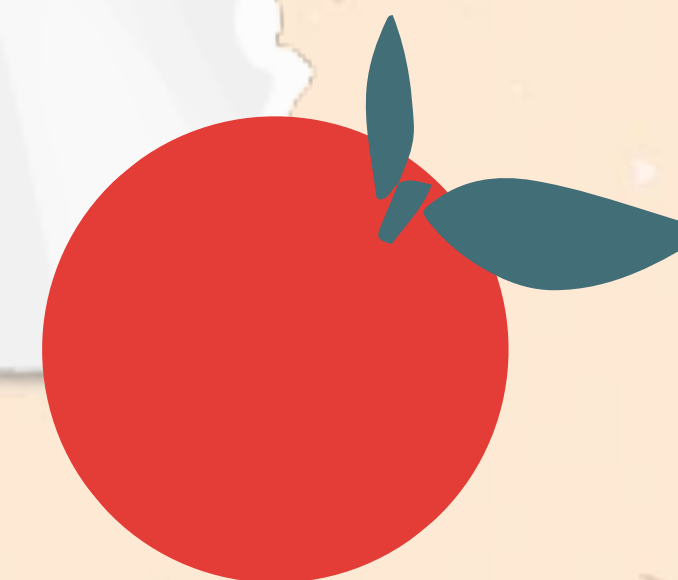

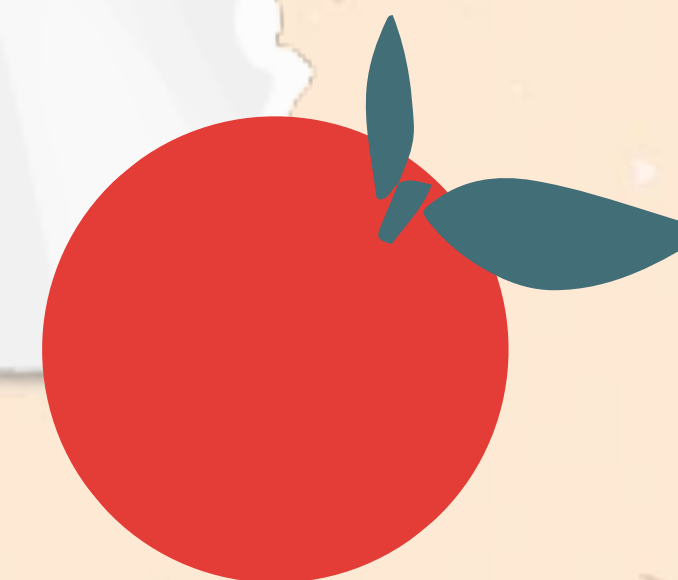
For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro

## Luke 17:5-10

-----

And the apostles said to the Lord, “Increase our faith.” <sup>6</sup> So the Lord said, “If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you. <sup>7</sup> And which of you, having a servant plowing or tending sheep, will say to him when he has come in from the field, ‘Come at once and sit down to eat’?

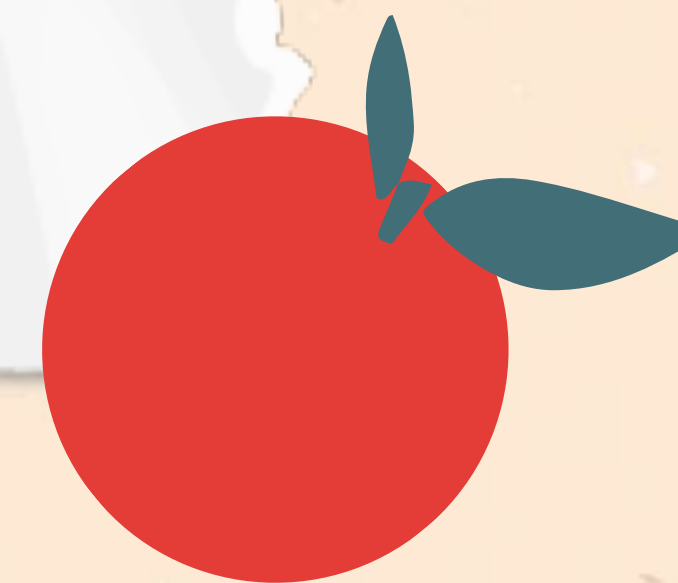
