# THINGS WE ARE COMMANDED TO TEACH OUR CHILDREN

① **SALVATION** (EX. 12:26)

We lead our children to a personal relationship with God.

---

② **10 COMMANDMENTS** (EX. 34:43, DEUT. 6:7)

Teach our children the 10 commandments.

---

③ **THE SABBATH** (EX. 31:13)

We build a pattern of Sabbath for our children.

---

④ **YOUR JOURNEY OF FAITH** (DEUT. 4:9)

Recite your journey of faith to your children.

---

⑤ **THE FEASTS OF THE LORD** (LV. 23:44)

Lead your children to an understanding of the experiences essential in their walk with God.

---

⑥ **THE SONG OF MOSES** (DEUT. 31:19)

Affect your children's taste of music with godly Christian music.

---

⑦ **HOLINESS** (LV. 19:2)

Teach your children about holiness and the choices that pleases God.

<sup>30</sup> Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?
