The Greatest Prayer in the Bible

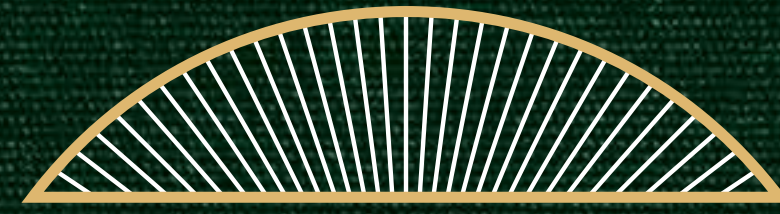
(John 17)

(Khayts)

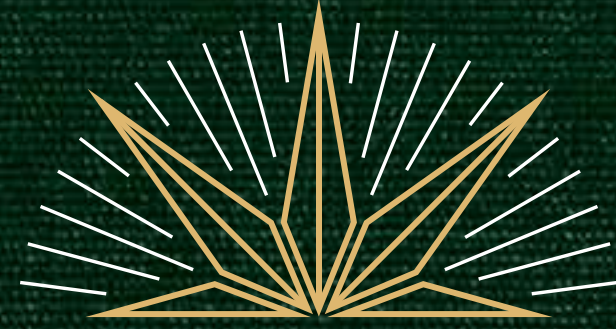
Destruction

To an Israelite, those Canaanite deities were **demonic**.

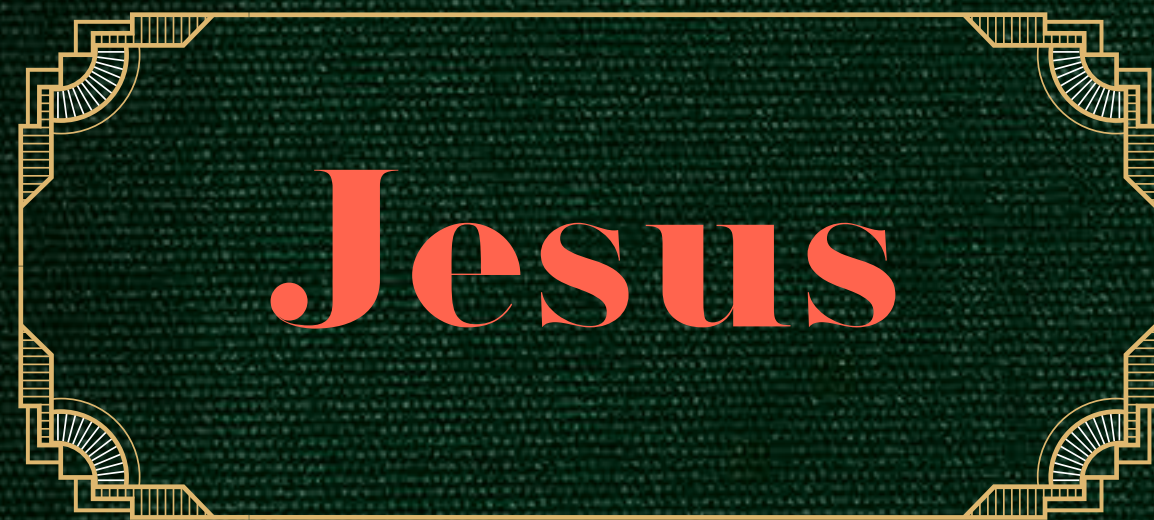
