



One of the facets of wisdom according to Proverbs 14:8 is for a man to understand his way.



It's called THE OLD MAN

Great Teacher Called **INTROSPECTION**

The fact that we often react the way we do is because that's our default mode behaviour.



If you are suffering, the correct default is to pray. If you are cheerful, sing psalms. ¹⁴ But if you are sick, the correct default is to call for the elders, not the doctors.

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience (endurance).

The word 'COUNT'is borrowed from the accounting profession. It literally means to make a mental note of, or to reckon 9+tc 9=0 - on a ledger.


