

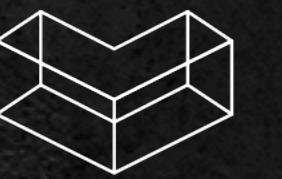
THE

at salvation.

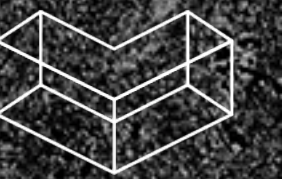


CORNERSTONE

Luke 3:15-16

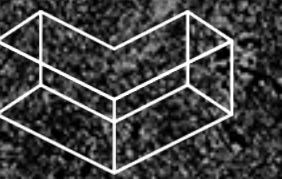


“I indeed baptise you with water;

in the Scriptures.

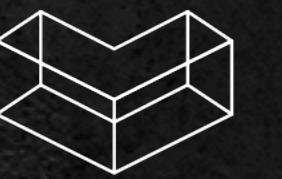
2) Fire **purifies or consumes.**

1) There's **no escaping fire** in the Scriptures.

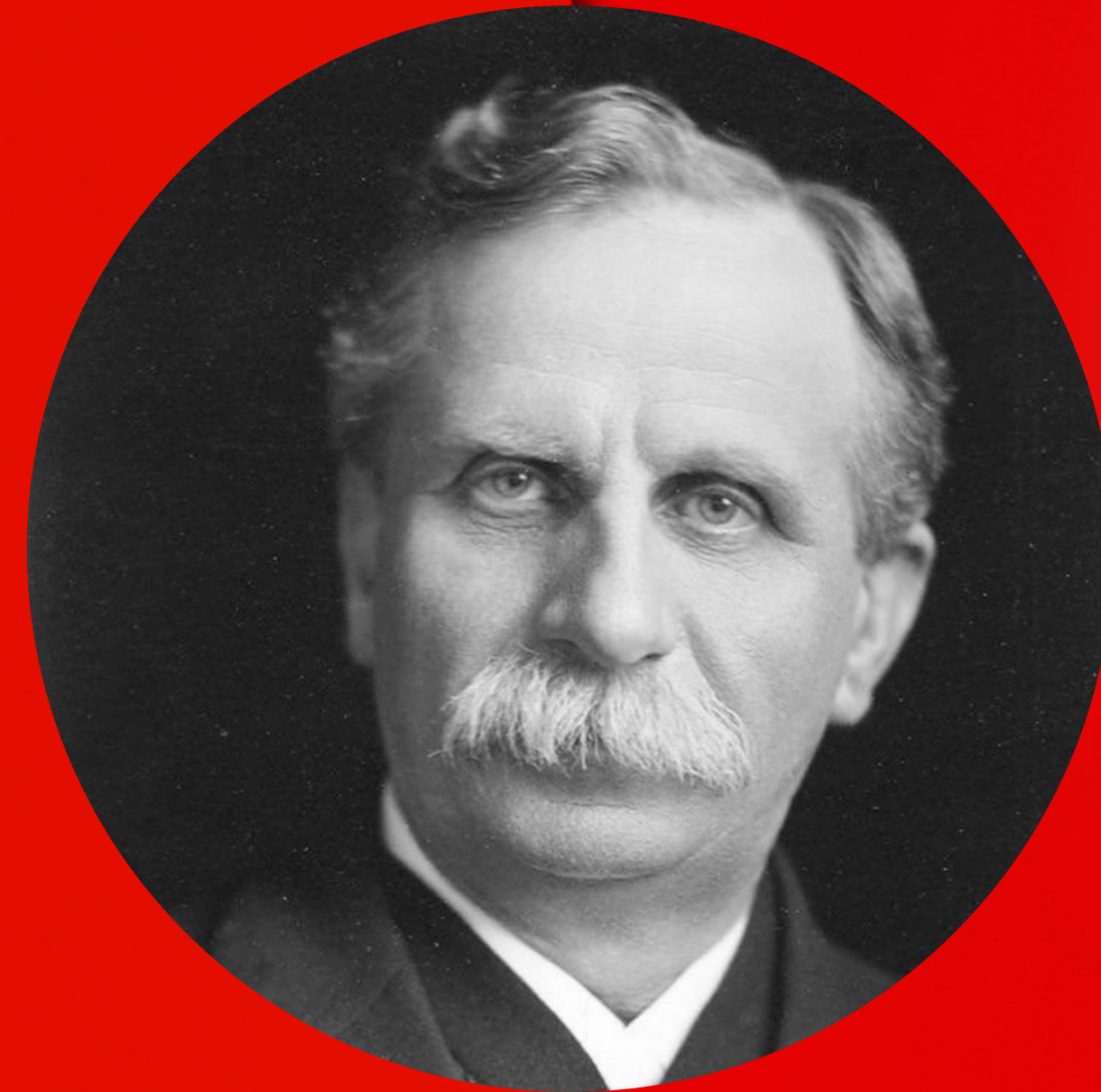
