**Him at all times.**

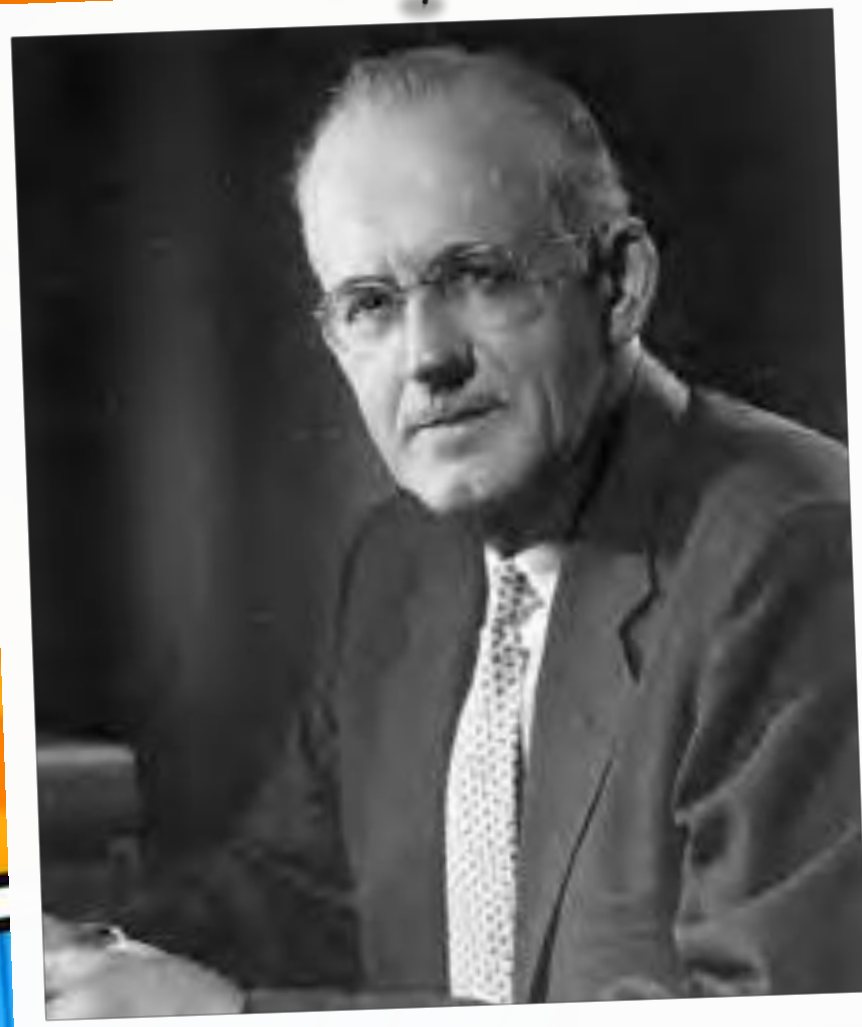




In order to truly
