


















Elijah went before the people and said, "How long will you waver between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow him; but if Baal is God, follow him."



### He asked the Lord to take his life away.




## 3 FINGS

God treated Elijah as a physical, relational, emotional, as well as a spiritual being.






## ELJAH GOTO








Centuries before, Elijah's predecessor Moses went up on Mount Horeb and said "I want to see Your glory."

Mount Horeb is another name for Mount Sinai.











It's possible that God is giving us our own mountaintop experience, but we're resisting and waiting to have someone else's.




### Elijah's limited view of God and how God works let him down.








Twice, Elijah responds with a mixture of truth and error.

Much of our unhappiness in life is because we're listening, instead of talking to ourselves.




### 1) EXPOSE THE LIE




3) DON'T RELY
