TWO INTERPRETATIONS

>Interpretation (1) Barak's response stems from lack of faith: He was disciplined with not getting the honour for the victory.

>Interpretation (2)

Barak was fully obedient, and was rewarded in the best way possible.

PRACTICAL TAKEAWAYS ABOUT GOD'S ASSIGNMENT
