So the two of them went together.

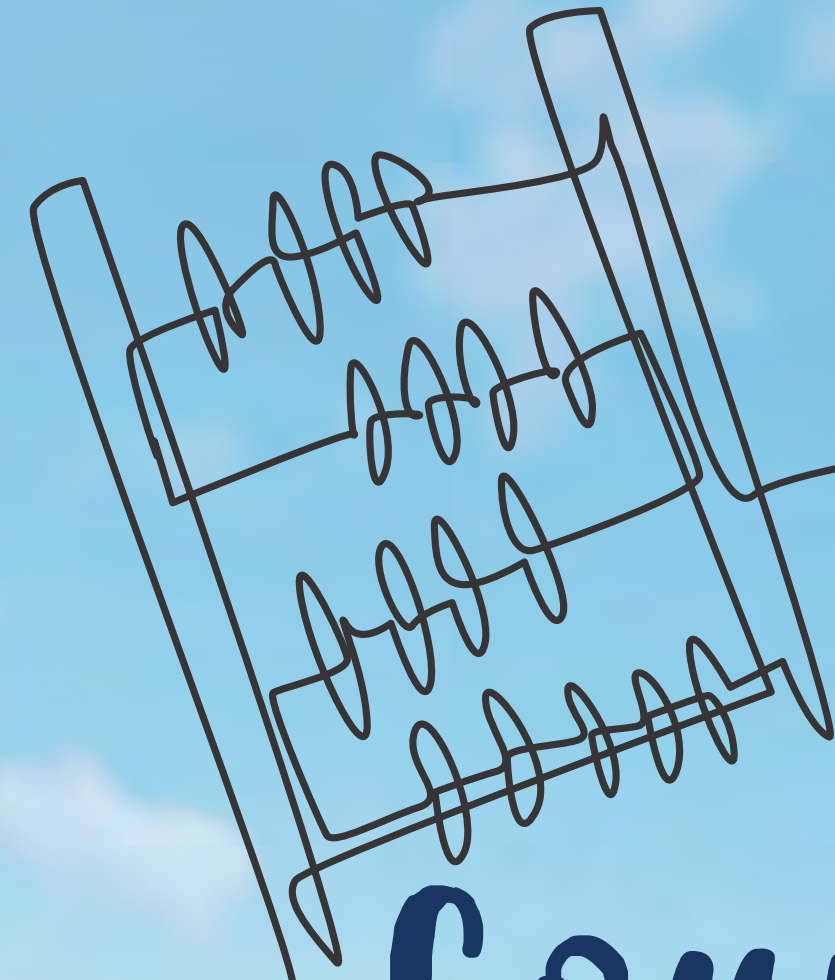

Then they came to the place of which God had told him. <sup>13</sup> Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, **and there behind him was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns.** So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. <sup>14</sup> And Abraham called the name of the place, **The-Lord-Will-Provide**; as it is said to this day, “In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided.”
