

1 Chronicles 13:13-14 (NKJV)

13 So David would not move the ark with him into the City of David, but took it aside into the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite. 14 The ark of God remained with the family of Obed-Edom in his house three months. And the Lord blessed the house of Obed-Edom and all that he had.

THREE STRIKES AGAINST OBED-EDOM

a. He was a slave and addressed as a slave
b. He was an enemy to Israelites
c. He was living in the wrong city – gath.

1 Chronicles 26:4-5 (NKJV)

⁴ Moreover the sons of *Obed-Edom were* Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third, Sacar the fourth, Nethanel the fifth,

⁵ Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peulthai the eighth; *for God blessed him.*

GOD BLESSED OBED-EDOM

Hebrew words for Blessing is "Barak" which means

To make a person a instrument of favor to stop misfortune
in the lives of people

HOLY SPIRIT REPRESENTED IN OIL TWO TYPES OF OIL

1. Olive Oil in the Lampstand—
Holy Spirit in me with an anointing in me (I john 2:20,27)

2. Anointing oil –

The Holy Spirit upon me with an anointing upon me for POWER (Acts 1:8)



Exodus 27:20-21 (NLT)

Command the people of Israel to bring you pure oil of pressed olives for the light, to keep the lamps burning continually. 21 The lampstand will stand in the Tabernacle, in front of the inner curtain that shields the Ark of the Covenant. Aaron and his sons must keep the lamps burning in the LORD's presence all night. This is a permanent law for the people of Israel, and it must be observed from generation to generation.



1. COMMUNION LAMP

2 Corinthians 13:14 (MSG)
The amazing grace of the Master, Jesus Christ,
the extravagant love of God,
the *intimate friendship of the Holy Spirit*, be with all of you.

(AMPC) ...the presence and fellowship (the communion and sharing together, and participation) in the Holy Spirit

James 4:4-5 (NKJV)

- ⁴ Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
- ⁵ Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us <u>yearns jealously</u>"?

ENVY

is when I want something that belongs to someone else

JEALOUSY

is when I want something that belongs to me, but someone else has

2. CONVICTING LAMP

an act of pleading, beseeching, or reproving,

Making us God conscious

John 16:8 (AMPC)

And when He comes, *He will convict and convince* the world and bring demonstration to it about sin and about righteousness (uprightness of heart and right standing with God) and about judgment:

3. COUNSELING LAMP

John 14:26 (AMPC)

But the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengthener, Standby), the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you.

4. COMPASSION LAMP

Romans 12:15 (AMPC)

Rejoice with those who rejoice [sharing others' joy], and weep with those who weep [sharing others' grief]

Ephesians 4:32 (AMPC) And become useful and helpful and kind to one another, tenderhearted (compassionate, understanding, loving-hearted), forgiving one another [readily and freely]...

5. CLEANSING LAMP

John 2:17 (AMPC) And His disciples remembered that it is written [in the Holy Scriptures], Zeal (the fervor of love) for Your house will eat Me up. [I will be consumed with jealousy for the honor of Your house.

6. COMMANDING LAMP

Acts 4:29-30 (NLT)

And now, O Lord, hear their threats, and give us, your servants, great boldness in preaching your word. 30 Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus."

7. CONQUERING LAMP

(I John 3:8)

- a. Holy spirit in this mood is joyful, triumphant in praise, victorious.
- b. This word in I John 3:8 means Jesus came to Out do, Undo, and overdo, and re-do, everything the devil ever did.
 - c. David (I Samuel 17:44)



John 7:37-38 (TPT)

Then on the most important day of the feast, the last day, Jesus stood and shouted out to the crowds—"All you thirsty ones, come to me! Come to me and drink! 38 Believe in me so that rivers of living water will burst out from within you, flowing from your innermost being, just like the Scripture says!"

Genesis 2:10-14 (NKJV)

Now a river went out of Eden to water the garden, and from there it parted and became *four riverheads*.

- 11 The name of the first is Pishon;
- 13 The name of the **second river** is **Gihon**;
- The name of the <u>third river is Hiddekel</u>;
 The <u>fourth river is the Euphrates</u>.

1. PISHON – Edification.

A. Encouragement ---building up people

B. Impartation

C. Blessing them (serving, giving money)

2. Gihon – (NILE) Revelation & Prophecy (it has the meaning of 'burst forth'

A. Spirit of prophecy is testimony of JesusB. Spontaneous songs of the LordC. Prophetic art, visions, and directions

3. Hiddekel (tigris) – POWER

A. Taking authority

B. Praying for healing

C. Demonstrating the KOG

4. Euphrates –Intercession

A. Praying for others

B. Fasting

C. Praise that brings breakthrough
