1 JOHN 4:1-6

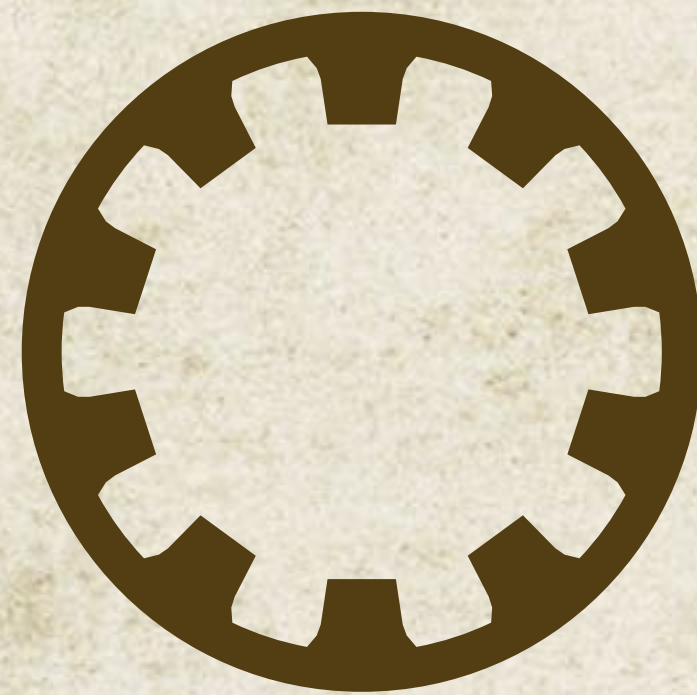

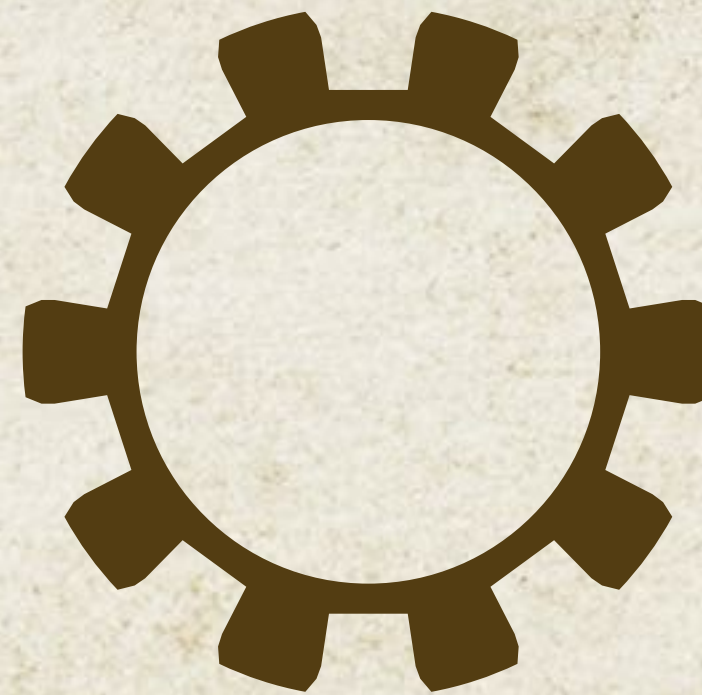
