Expansion in Ephesus Acts 19

Extraordinary miracles were seen (verse 11-12)

The socio-economic climate of the city was changed (verse 23-27)

The transformation caused a riot (verse 28-32)



The Word was taught daily for 2 years in the Hall of Tyrannus (verse 9-10)

Casting out demons was a common occurrence (verse 13-16)



Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first. ⁵ Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place. 6 But you have this in your favor: You hate the practices of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. 7 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.
