LUKE 22:14-20

When the hour came, Jesus and His apostles reclined at the table. <sup>15</sup> And He said to them, “I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. <sup>16</sup> **For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfilment in the Kingdom of God.”** <sup>17</sup> **After taking the cup**, He gave thanks and said, “Take this and divide it among you. <sup>18</sup> **For I tell you I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until the Kingdom of God comes.”**

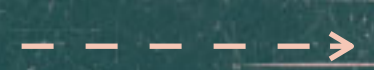

# THE PRAYER IN THE GARDEN

MATTHEW 26:36-46

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to the disciples, “Sit here while I go and pray over there.”

<sup>37</sup> And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed.

<sup>38</sup> Then He said to them, “My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch with Me.”

<sup>39</sup> He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, “O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as **You will.**”

<sup>40</sup> Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?”

<sup>41</sup> Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.”

<sup>42</sup> Again, a second time, He went away and prayed, saying, “O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from Me unless I drink it, Your will be done.”

<sup>43</sup> And He came and found them asleep again, for their eyes were heavy.

ISAIAH 51:17 “You who have drunk at the hand of the Lord the **cup of His wrath.**”

JEREMIAH 25:15 “Take this wine **cup of fury** from My hand.”

PSALM 75:8 “In the hand of the Lord is a **cup [of wrath]** full of foaming wine mixed with spices;”
