

# *Phinehas #1*

So Moses ordered Israel's judges, "Each of you must put to death the men under your authority who have joined in worshipping Baal of Peor."

Numbers 25:5 (NLT)

Just then one of the Israelite men **brought a Midianite woman into his tent**, right before the eyes of Moses and all the people, as **everyone was weeping** at the entrance of the Tabernacle.

Numbers 25:6 (NLT)



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When **Phinehas** son of Eleazar and grandson of Aaron the priest saw this, he jumped up and left the assembly. He took a spear <sup>8</sup> and rushed after the man into his tent. Phinehas thrust the spear all the way through the man's body and into the woman's stomach. So the plague against the Israelites was stopped, <sup>9</sup> but **not before 24,000 people had died.**

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**Phinehas**... has turned back My wrath from the children of Israel, because he was zealous with My zeal among them... Therefore, I give to him My covenant of peace; and it shall be to him and his descendants after him a covenant of an everlasting priesthood...

(1 Samuel 4:21)
