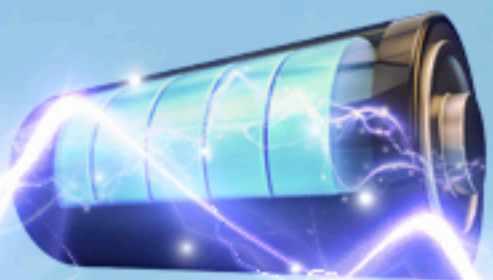
# *Two things we need to understand*
