

And Elisha said to him (Jehoash, King of Israel), "Take a bow and some arrows." So he took himself a bow and some arrows. ¹⁶ Then he said to the king of Israel, "Put your hand on the bow." So he put his hand on it, and Elisha put his hands on the king's hands.

And he said, "Open the **east window**"; and he opened it. Then Elisha said, "Shoot"; and he shot. And he said, "The arrow of the Lord's deliverance and the arrow of deliverance from Syria; for you must strike the Syrians at **Aphek** till you have destroyed them."

2 Kings 13:17





Then he said, "Take the arrows"; so he took them. And he said to the king of Israel, "Strike the ground"; so he struck three times, and stopped. ¹⁹ And the man of God was angry with him, and said, "You should have struck five or six times; then you would have struck Syria till you had destroyed it!

But now you will strike Syria only three times."

SPIRITUAL SIGNIFICANCE OF APHEK

'Aphek' = fortress or strength

(In Hebrew) representing something fortified or unyielding.





THE 'BATTLE OF TWO SYRIAS'

'Syria' (Aram) = exalted or elevated

(In Hebrew) symbolising pride or self-exaltation.

- External Syria the war on the land
- Internal Syria the war within Jehoash's heart
