The act of bowing down in reverence and submission to God, expressing honour, obedience, and surrender of the heart, will, and actions.












Offering what's Precious – Worship becomes Sacrifice

Worship that **costs** nothing, **means** nothing – and **reveals** nothing.




Worship didn't begin when Abraham built the altar on the mountain – it began the moment he took his first step of obedience toward God.



"And Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son." (verse 10)










- Offering what's Perplexing Worship becomes Provision Revealed


