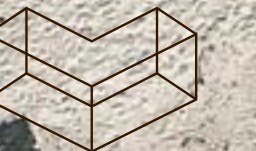

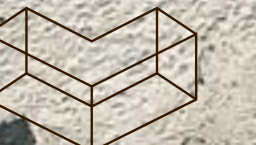

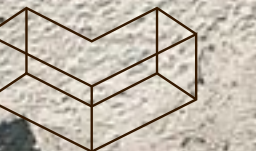

To preach, to proclaim, to tell of the good news.

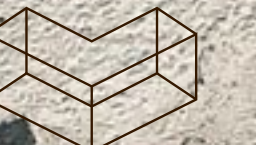

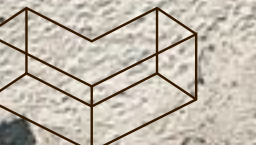

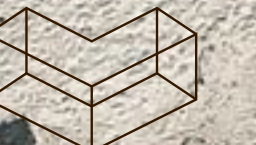

Do you not say, “There are still four months and then comes the harvest?” Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!

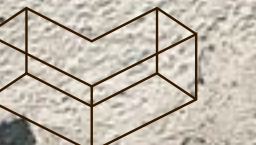


MATTHEW
