ANOINTING OF RECOGNITION.

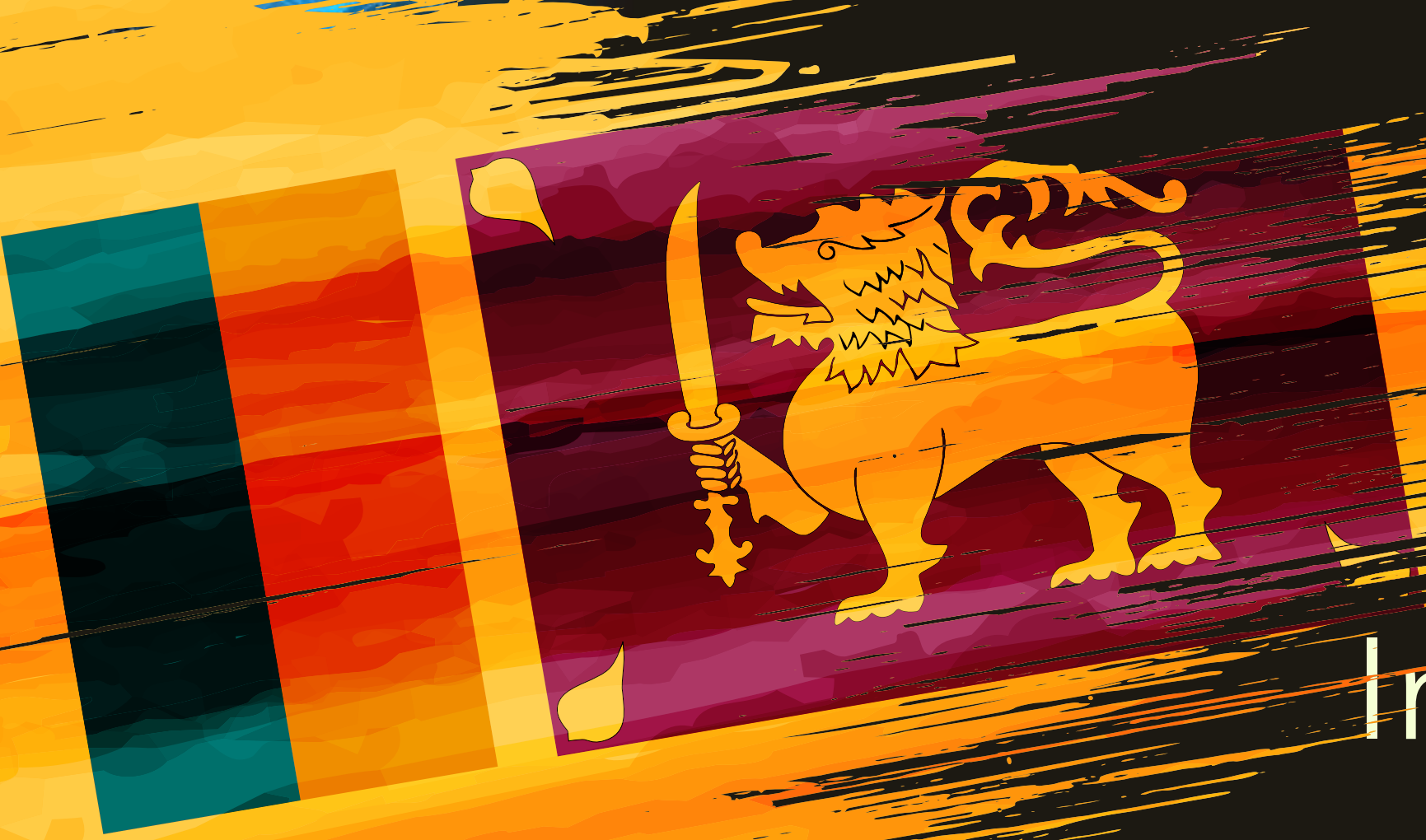




Psalms 89:19
